Legislative/Political Affairs: Responsible for proactively representing the Association's interest in public policy matters at the State level, as well as local public policy issues, developing and participating in coalitions, supporting CTR and NAR's political programs and promoting effective REALTOR® involvement in the political process.

Political Fund Raising: Responsible for coordinating the Association's RPAC fundraising and Issues Advocacy campaigns.

Awards Committee: This committee reviews nominations and applications for all NHMR Awards and determines award recipients.

Professional Standards: To educate members on ethical conduct; to arbitrate disputes; and to follow through on complaints pertaining to the ethical conduct of REALTORS®. In order to serve on this committee, a member must have served on the Grievance Committee for at least one year.

Community Relations: This committee develops realistic programs and projects that will reinforce public awareness and respect for REALTORS®.

Committee members must complete an intensive 2-day Professional Standards course and receive the PSCS designation.

Young Professionals Network (YPN): A dynamic entry point for real estate professionals striving to become more successful in their careers and gain leadership experience. The purpose of this committee is to build a new, diverse generation of leaders, strengthen members' affinity for the REALTOR® brand early in their career, and gain a valuable perspective on generational shifts through networking & events. Open to all Members Young at Heart.

Grievance: Responsible for determining whether there is any validity to a complaint that would justify holding a hearing. Committee members must complete an intensive 2-day Professional Standards course and receive the PSCS designation. Committee meets only when necessary.

Scholarship: Responsible for promoting the Scholarship to REALTOR members of the Association for their children/grandchildren, who are seniors graduating from High School. Also reviews all applications and determines who the recipients will be.
